On April 4, 1988 we consigned twenty-two (22) cases for export whose contents were the most valuable works of art which we had removed, packed and crated from 121 East 64th Street, New York, N.Y. and from Jacob Freres Ltd., 1018 Madison Avenue, New York, N.Y. to SEKO AIR FREIGHT, INC. with instruction to ship the same to:

The carrier that flew the works of art to France was AIR FRANCE (Airway Bill No. 1455-4326). The customs supervision was done by PADIIX GROUP INTERNATIONAL. The shipment was insured by AMERICAN MOTORISTS INSURANCE COMPANY.

It took between four to six months from the date that the works of art were removed from the premises at 121 East 64th Street, New York, N.Y. and the Gallery of Jacob Freres Ltd. at 1018 Madison Avenue, New York, N.Y.

The works of art were not shipped directly from the house and the gallery. It was an elaborate process which involved the removal and placement of the works of art in different locations.

The Insurance Proforma Invoice for the shipment to France was signed by Nicholas Fromanger, an employee of Jacob Freres Ltd.

We received all instructions concerning all of the abovementioned transactions solely from Mrs. Rosa Polo.

We know that Rosa Franco is Mrs. Roberto C. Polo.

Milani Movers, Inc. were paid for the abovementioned services of packing, crating and shipping by Nicholas Fromanger of Jacob Freres, Ltd.


